GAAF's HYDROCEPHALUS PROJECT Help us save children with Hydrocephalus in the Philippines

HYDROCEPHALUS is a buildup of fluid inside the skull that leads to brain swelling. Hydrocephalus means "water on the brain." It is due to a problem with the flow of fluid that surrounds the brain. The fluid is called cerebrospinal fluid, or CSF

Without treatment, up to 6 in 10 children with hydrocephalus will die.

TREATMENT:

To reduce or prevent damage, the flow of CSF has to be improved. Surgery may be done if possible but if not, a flexible tube called a "shunt" may be placed in the brain to re-route the flow of CSF. The "shunt" sends CSF to another part of the body, such as the belly where it can be absorbed.
