DAY 1 DEPART LOS ANGELES

February 6, 2018

DAY 2 TEL-AVIV

February 7, 2018

DAY 3 BETHLEHEM SHEPHERD'S FIELD

EIN KAREM

February 8, 2018

After breakfast we leave for Bethlehem at the Church of the Nativity, where our Savior was born. We will also visit Shepherd's Field and Milk Grotto. After lunch, we will shop for souvenirs at a Christian owned store. In the afternoon, we will visit Ein Karem, the hometown and birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the place where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth.

DAY 4 VIA DOLOROSA WAILING WALL MOUNT ZION

February 9, 2018

Early in the morning, we walk the way of the Cross with early mass at the Holy Sepulcher Church. In here, we will visit Golgotha,

Holy Sepulcher, where Jesus was laid after he was removed from the Cross and his tomb. Return to our hotel for breakfast. We return to the Wall city to visit the Wailing Wall, Church of St. Anne, the birthplace of the Blessed Mother and the Pool of Bethesda. In the afternoon we will visit Mt. Zion including the upper room where Last Supper, the Institution of the Holy Eucharist and Pentecost took place. We also pass by King David's Tomb.

DAY 5 MT. OF OLIVES PATER NOSTER DOMINUS FLEUIT GALICANTU BETHANY

February 10, 2018

After breakfast, we start the day with a visit to Bethany which includes the empty Tomb of Lazarus. On to the Mt. of Olives, the Church of the Pater Noster, Church of the Ascension and down to Dominus Fleuit and St. Magdalene Church. Pray at the Garden of Gethsemane and visit the Church of All Nations. In the afternoon, we visit the Dormition Abbey of the Blessed Virgin Mary then to St. Peter in Gallicantu where Jesus was denied by St. Peter three times. Drive around Knesset, Shrine of the Book, Parliament and Mt. Scopus.

DAY 6 JERUSALEM CAESARIA HAIFA NAZARETH

February 11, 2018

We depart Jerusalem and drive to Haifa, en route we pass by Caesaria to see the ruins of the ancient Roman City with its aqueduct. In Haifa,

we visit the Carmelite Monastery and the Church of the Prophet Elijah. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Church of the Annunciation, Church of St. Joseph and Mary's Well.

DAY 7

CANA

February 12, 2018

After breakfast, we visit Cana of Galilee where we celebrate renewal of wedding vows and mass. Then, we will visit the sites where the message of our faith was given, visiting the heart of the ministry sites also known as the Gospel Triangle. We begin our visit with a boat ride at the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, The primacy of St. Peter, Tabgha, the Multiplication of loaves and fish. We will have a quick stop at Mt. Tabor where the Transfiguration took place. Dinner at the hotel.

After breakfast we drive to the ancient city of Jericho to view the Mt. Temptation and Zacchaeus' Tree. We stop at the Baptismal site on the Jordan River and cross the border where we will meet our guide and bus driver. Check-in into hotel adjacent to the Dead Sea. Access to the Dead Sea is available for swimming.

PETRA

February 14, 2018

This morning after mass, we drive to Petra for an unforgettable visit to the "Rose Red City". Here you see the Nabateans built temples, houses, tombs and aqueducts. Back to Amman for dinner.

DAY 10

MT. NEBO

MADABA

JERASH

February 15, 2018

After breakfast, a visit to the ancient city of Jerash, which is now generally acknowledged to be one of the best-preserved Roman provincial towns in the world. We then drive to the summit of Mt. Nebo to view the "Promise Land" as shown by Moses to the Israelites. Then we drive to Madaba to visit the church where the 6th century mosaic map of the Holy Land is located. Farewell dinner in Amman.

DAY 11

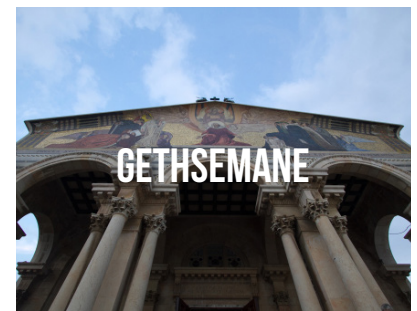

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

REGISTRATION: A complete enrollment form; copy of passport; and a deposit of \$350 are required upon registration. Full payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Booking 60 days or less prior to departure, a full payment is required.

TOUR PRICES/PAYMENTS: All prices quoted in flyers and brochures are quoted in US Dollars and are based on airfares, land tour rates and exchange rates in effect at the time the flyers were printed on a group rate of 35 or more passengers. Tour prices on flyers reflect discount for payment made by cash or check. You may use credit card for payment over the phone using Credit Card Authorization form, a 4 % surcharge will be added to the total amount paid. You may use credit card for payment in person, a 3% surcharge will be added to the total amount paid.

INSURANCE: Insurance coverage is not included in the tour price. Although, travel insurance is optional **TRAVELERS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO PURCHASE THEIR TRAVELERS INSURANCE.**

PASSPORT/VISA/DOCUMENTS: A valid US passport is required for US Citizens; validity must be at least 6 months after return date; US and Canadians national usually do not require visa in most countries; Non US passport holders should call the Consulate Office of the countries to be visited to obtain Visa. The agency is not responsible to secure visa to Non-US Nationals. No refunds will be made to a traveler delayed or denied entry to an aircraft or foreign countries.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: A written cancellation letter and supporting documents, once partial or full payments were made is required. There is a \$200 administrative fee per person for cancellation. Once full payment is made, the following will apply:

90-60 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 25% of tour cost will apply.

59-30 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 50% of tour cost will apply.

29-15 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 75% of tour cost will apply.

14 days or less prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 100% of tour cost will apply.

Cancellation fees will not be waived due to illness. No refunds will be issued for any missed excursions, transfers, and accommodations. All airline tickets issued in conjunction with this tour are subject to separate airline penalties, per individual carriers rules and regulations.
